Program Overview

The pharmaceutical industry is a branch of industry that manufactures synthetic, herbal, animal-derived, and biological chemical substances used for therapeutic, preventive, and diagnostic purposes in human and veterinary medicine in accordance with pharmaceutical technology and makes them available for treatment. Driven by demographic change, increasing life expectancy, changes in disease patterns, social globalization, significant improvements in access to healthcare services, and the emergence of the welfare state, the pharmaceutical industry has experienced rapid growth in recent years. It is now the third-largest industry worldwide and ranks among the sectors that generate the highest added value. Medicines are among the most important factors in protecting public health, delivering healthcare services effectively and efficiently, and maintaining a healthy life. Pharmacies ensure that medicines reach everyone who needs them at the appropriate time. They are also among the most important primary healthcare institutions in terms of direct communication with patients. Qualified, well-trained, and specialized personnel are required to ensure that patients receive high-quality and efficient healthcare services and that healthcare institutions can adapt to changing technologies. The Pharmacy Services Program was established to meet this need and offers graduates a broad range of career opportunities.

Our graduates complete the program with the knowledge, skills, and competencies required to work in the healthcare sector, particularly in institutions providing pharmacy services. Through the Pharmacy Services Program, students learn the principal healthcare procedures related to prescription and non-prescription medicines and medical products. They also develop an awareness of the importance of continuously improving themselves in line with innovations in the healthcare system. Students acquire professional knowledge through both theoretical and practical education. They become familiar with healthcare legislation and relevant procedures, learn to use professional equipment and new technologies, and gain the skills necessary to maintain accurate and systematic records in institutions providing pharmacy services under the supervision of a pharmacist. They also gain knowledge of the structure and physiology of both healthy and ill individuals and develop an understanding of the positive impact that the rational use of medicines has on society. Our graduates may find employment in pharmacies affiliated with public hospitals, university hospitals, and private hospitals, as well as in community pharmacies, pharmaceutical manufacturing companies, and pharmaceutical warehouses.

In addition, through the Vertical Transfer Examination held annually, graduates may transfer to bachelor's degree programs such as Chemistry, Biochemistry, Chemical Engineering, and Chemical Engineering and Applied Chemistry.
